2. File types:

.swf – Flash file. Requires a flash plug-in player for your browser. Most browsers already have this installed. If you require a plug-in, please go [here](#).

.avi - Audio Video Interleave File. This file will play in Windows Media Player. If you require Windows Media Player, please go [here](#).

.wmv – Windows Media File. This file will play in Windows Media Player. If you require Windows Media Player, please go [here](#).

.jar – Compressed file containing many files. You require Sun Java run-time environment to display this file. It can be downloaded [here](#). If you have WinRAR installed on your computer, you may have to uninstall it, otherwise it will try to open the file.

3. If prompted, choose **OPEN** to view the video now. If you would like to save the video to view later, right click and **SAVE TARGET AS...**
